Greetings, and great blessings in this New Year. We are amazed by what God has already begun to do, and what He has taught us in this first month.


We believe we are in new learning about FAITH, which challenges us and us to endure external circumstances, which we cannot control.

In Guayaquil, Abigail and the girls had the opportunity to attend the Coast District Assembly and share the project with the Pastors.




