4 The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds. 5 We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ.



"Believing Lies"



We need to recognize unhealthy thoughts and lies and refocus them.
Happily, The Apostle Paul explains what to do:

1. Declare that it is a lie and
2. Exchange the lie for the truth, usually using the Scriptures, our sword of truth.

Recognizing the lie is difficult because sometimes it is up to 95 percent correct.

Imagine if a military tank were on the street. We would say, "A tank. Watch out. It's dangerous." But imagine if someone took a pipe and put it under the door and a carbon monoxide gas came in. You don't smell it. You don't notice anything. It's hard to distinguish the toxic until you feel sleepy and sleep, you'll never get up.

Some dangers and lies are easier to see, like this tank. There are deeper ones that have entered like a gas, and make us live as if they were the truth.

EXAMPLES OF LIES WE HAVE HEARD IN MISSIONS.

1. You must first win all of Ecuador before evangelizing another nation.
2. We are in crisis, and cannot support missions because the situation is difficult.
3. Our country has more needs than others.

Lies like these and others, the enemy uses so that we do not participate in the mission of God, however, one thing is certain, we are in a spiritual battle and this must be fought in prayer, fasting, and intercession so that we can enjoy the joy of being able to give and get involved in the many ways in the missionary work.

We thank God for the brave and sensitive ones who have believed the Word of God rather than the snare of the enemy, and we pray for those who need to be enlightened by the word of the Lord, to obey the Great Commission.

We have already reached 78 in FAITH pledges, we are very close to the goal, and we trust in the Lord to surpass 100 before our departure to the field. We are waiting for the answers from many pastors and churches regarding the FAITH pledge.
